Go wild for reading at your local library with the Wild World Heroes Summer Reading Challenge!

Wiltshire Council Libraries are encouraging families to take part in this year's wild-themed Summer Reading Challenge which aims to inspire children to read as much as they can.

The challenge encourages 4 to 11 year olds to read six or more library books (including eBooks) during the summer holidays and receiving rewards along the way.

The simple and fun Summer Reading Challenge is produced annually by the Reading Agency and delivered by Wiltshire Council libraries. The challenge is the perfect summer activity to build young readers' skills and confidence during the long break from school and will support reading catch-up after a difficult year.

This year, the Reading Agency has partnered with WWF (World Wide Fund for Nature) to create 'Wild World Heroes', inspiring children to take action for nature and the environment as part of an exciting adventure in the fictional town of 'Wilderville'. Through reading books, collecting rewards and learning all about the planet, participants will help the Heroes make Wilderville a greener place to live.


The free challenge will run from Saturday 10 July until Saturday 4 September. Packs of materials, including a map of Wilderville and stickers, can be picked up from libraries from 10 July, while stocks last. From Monday 2 August, and once children have read their six library books, they can collect their gold medal and certificate from their local library.

Children can read whatever books they like for the challenge (they don't have to be part of the theme), libraries have a huge range to choose from and staff can help families find suitable books if needed. Wiltshire Council's eBooks, eAudio and eMagazines page also has an extensive list of ereading materials.

Children will need a library card to take part in the challenge and to borrow books, for more information on joining the library and all Wiltshire library services visit: www.wiltshire.gov.uk/libraries.

This year, some aspects of the challenge will be run slightly differently to maintain COVID-19 safety measures. A few of the changes include: libraries not being able to listen to the children talk about their books, the core materials being handed out in bags, and libraries will be encouraging families to visit at the quieter times such as afternoons as there may be queues.

St. Mary's Church during 2020

A summary of the annual report produced by Mr Ben Bannister, PCC Secretary

St. Mary's Church was closed throughout 2020, not just because of COVID but also so that essential work could be done in the church

All the previously broken windows have been repaired.

The church now has an electrical certificate. This is probably the first time the wiring has been inspected. Remedying all the problems identified will cost about £3000.

An asbestos survey has been competed, asbestos was found and it will cost up to £2,000 to remove it safely.

Health and Safety work has been started on the Tower Stairs. Mesh has been fitted across the windows to keep birds out, the bell chamber has been cleaned and the bells are in working order, but will need a professional inspection soon.

Work has started on refurbishing the Bier house roof, and the bier has been moved into the church to keep it dry.

Work has to be done to keep water away from the North wall where the inside of the church is below ground level. This may involve digging a "French drain" and redirecting water from the North wall gutters.

When pews were moved, it was discovered that joists under the floor boards were rotting and needed to be replaced.

Advice is being sought about disposing of the pews from the north and south aisles and the west end of the main nave, many of these are suffering from rot and woodworm.

Some items of work on the organ were done in 2019, and additional work was completed in 2020

A recurring theme at PCC meetings has been the need to develop a longer term vision and strategy for the future of St. Mary's, Much is dependent on the Salisbury Diocesan Advisory Committee to approve the modest improvement plans. Within the wider community the church is seen as a dark, dank unwelcoming place, which puts people off attending, yet the evidence of Christmas, Easter and Remembrance services indicates that there is community interest in the church.

The aim is to bring the church back into more general community use, as part of a broader campus strategy (Community Centre – Old School—Museum – Church), with the intent to use the church building itself for more general community use. This would also generate income to contribute towards the running costs of this historic grade 1 listed building.







Following our enforced Covid break last year, we are pleased to announce that Imberbus will be running again this year on


Saturday 21st August 2021

ECO - CORNER WILDLIFE SURVEY ALL SAINTS' WEST LAVINGTON 5-13 JUNE 2021

There was good support for West Lavington Parish's first attempt at taking part in the Churches Count for Nature initiative – seeking to build a picture of the range of wildlife that is already present in the churchyard in order to assist in planning how to make it more biodiverse with a view to protecting, creating and enhancing nature in the community area.

22 survey sheets were completed during the week of the survey, 5 of them by children. One parent reported being asked to walk through the churchyard every time they go for a walk so their child could look for wildlife!

The results were collated across the open and closed burial grounds:

The list of identified species has been submitted to be verified and uploaded onto the National Biodiversity Database.

These figures provide very helpful baseline data which will inform the plan for increasing the biodiversity in the churchyard, most importantly how to increase the number of insects and birds.

Areas where the grass will be left to grow have been marked off and already there is an increase in the number of flowers growing amongst the grass e.g. 15 orchid plants were counted on Tuesday, 22nd June.

The proposal is to repeat the nature survey next year, expanding it to include a nature trail around the two burial grounds. In the meantime, it would interesting to focus on identifying one type of wildlife at regular intervals throughout the year, e.g. birds in January, lichens in the autumn. We think it would also be useful to keep a running count of species to capture the variety over the year.

A Message from Cllr Dominic Muns Wiltshire Councillor for The Lavingtons

How beautiful our villages are in the Summer! Due to the heat this last week we delayed our family walks and bike rides until the evenings. It's my favourite time of day to be out in the countryside. Walking from the water tower at Tilshead over the plain and back down into West Lavington, the wildflowers seemed endless, butterflies danced constantly and the heat rose up from the paths which had baked in the sun all day. On Friday, Buddy and I took our bikes out for an eleven mile loop from West Lavington up Stibb Hill, down to Gore Cross to New Zealand, around to Peartree Hill, along the ridge above the Cheverells, before dropping down behind Dauntseys. For a 10-year-old to declare unprompted, "We are lucky to live in such an amazing place", made my heart melt. He's absolutely right.

The strict policing of Peartree over the last 18 months, which saw many people getting a stern warning or even a ticket for driving or parking off the track, seemed a little heavy-handed to me at the time. I wasn't aware that you couldn't drive on the grass and nor was anyone else I spoke to last year! Coming down Peartree Hill at 9pm on my bike last week it all made sense. In the thirty years I've walked or eaten a picnic on that beautiful hill I've never seen the grasses and wildflowers like they are now. It was like an African savannah after the rains have come. Incredible!

Last month I mentioned that trees were going out of fashion. Aside from the number lost to industrial logging worldwide, most planning applications we receive locally are for tree removal. A lot of these are due to Ash Dieback or monster Leylandii but it's always a shame to see something cut down. For years now West Lavington has been responding to every application with a request that a new tree be planted either on site or via a tree planting scheme. This month I wrote to the Cabinet member for planning to request that this become a standard footnote to all approval notices for tree work. It won't be legally binding, however, it will hopefully encourage everyone to reduce the nett loss of Wiltshire's trees.

I must apologise to the two people that wrote to me recently concerned that I didn't see the beauty or importance of Stonehenge! I can be pretty sarcastic at times and my tongue-in-cheek tone in last month's magazine went under the radar of some. Of course I love Stonehenge, both for its beauty and incredible history as well as the boost to our local businesses through the tourism it attracts. Last week I wrote to our Public Transport team to request a re-routing of the Devizes-Salisbury bus in order to provide a better link to Stonehenge. As an aside I also requested an extension to the timetable to allow people working or studying in Salisbury or Devizes to get to and from their destination at the start and end of the working day.

Finally, work continues to find a solution at Black Dog crossroads. Numerous ideas were examined by Atkins and put out to Parish Councils for consultation. The responses have now gone back to the Highways team combining the voices of residents who have made their thoughts known over the years. Now I await a single proposal which I will take back to all the Parish Councils for discussion. Watch this space... but perhaps don't hold your breath.
