#### Reflection for October.

I wonder if you have been baptised (or if you were brought up like me, Christened). If so, it most probably took place when you were a baby, well before you had the ability to remember the service. So, apart from a service that named you, officially, what did it all mean. Has it, does it, will it or could it have a profound effect on your wellbeing.

I don't know about the service of baptism you received; I can only talk about the service I perform when asked by parents living in the benefice where I am rector.

A child brought to me is welcomed into the church — not the building but the family of Christ, the men, women, and young people that believe in the presence of God and through being open to God, live according to the teaching of Jesus of Nazareth, the Christ. He or she is anointed with oil blessed by the bishop in Salisbury solely for the purpose of baptism before holy water us used in the name of Father, Son and Holy Spirit at the time of naming. Personally, I like to move to the altar and introduce the child to God by name and impart God's blessing. But what does God offer that makes baptism is so important to many parents that often don't attend or support their Church. I like to read from the bible the following passage from the book of Isaiah.

Thus says the LORD,

"Do not fear, for I have redeemed you;

I have called you by name, you are mine.

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you;

and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you;

when you walk through fire you shall not be burned,

and the flame shall not consume you.

For I am the LORD your God,

the Holy One of Israel, your Saviour."

What a promise, what reassurance we have through baptism for the whole of our lives. So, can baptism influence our wellbeing? Yes, by knowing that in this promise, we are loved by God.

May God, our Father through baptism, give you his blessing, his love, and his protection. Amen.

This a presentation of the speeds recorded on Spin Hill during one week in September.



This means that prosecutions are more likely to happen.



In May 2020, Wiltshire Council, working with the Devizes Development Partnership, was successful in being awarded funding (up to £50,000) from the Department for Transport's (DfT's) Restoring Your Railway Ideas Fund to develop a Strategic Outline Business Case (SOBC) for Devizes Gateway Station.

Following discussions with the DfT and a period of project mobilisation, in February 2021 Wiltshire Council commissioned its term consultant, Atkins, and Logictree Consulting Ltd to develop the SOBC. In addition to the DfT grant (referenced above), funding has been utilised from the Devizes Area Board, relevant S106 agreement(s) and Wiltshire Council.

The draft SOBC was produced in May 2021 and submitted to the DfT for comment. The DfT (with Network Rail) provided their comments on the draft SOBC in mid-July. While welcoming the progress made in developing the strategic case (the most important of the cases at this stage) and the level of stakeholder engagement, the DfT and Network Rail asked for further details on the following matters:


Operational feasibility: Train service specification

Freight services uplift

Economic case:

Capital costs

Demand forecasting



Given the above, Wiltshire Council has liaised with Atkins to develop a proposal to address the DfT and Network Rail comments. This is currently being considered in the context of available budgets and funding opportunities. Ultimately, it is anticipated that a revised SOBC will be submitted to the Devizes Gateway Station Steering Group for approval prior to submission to the DfT by the end of October 2021 at the latest.

If the SOBC submission is successful through the Restoring Your Railway process, the DfT will fund up to 100% of further development costs for schemes (i.e. for the development of the Outline Business Case and Full Business Case). In stating this as 'up to 100%', the DfT is encouraging scheme promoters to contribute to these costs through financial contributions or work in kind. The DfT has also emphasised that any local contributions made through the development stage will be taken into account when considering whether a scheme should proceed to delivery.

In the event the submission is not successful, the development of a strong SOBC will enable the Council to more readily take advantage of other funding opportunities as they arise.

Over the last few years the Parish Council has done what it can to keep the Bridleway safe within the limits of its powers and funding. At other times we have had to say that things can not be done without the landowners permission, but no one has known who the landowners are.

We have been told that it belongs to the Parish Council, Wiltshire Council, the owners of the fields and houses south of The Clays, or equally down the middle by both sides.

We need to find out who owns The Clays , and what the rights and responsibilities of the owners on each side are, so that when a request is made we know whose permission we need to "to do something about The Clays"

When we have the information we need this copies will be archived in case future councils need this information.



For more than 80 years the Citizens Advice service has been providing free, confidential, independent advice to anyone who needs it.

The service started the day after World War Two broke out and gave advice to whoever needed it on a range of issues including evacuation, what to do if they'd lost their home and how to get a new ration book.

We're still doing much of the same today, whether that's helping people keep a roof over their heads, or issuing food bank vouchers. But Covid-19 has had a big impact on the way we give advice.

While the pandemic meant we had to close our doors, we continued to help people by giving advice over the phone, by email and web chat.

Over the past 18 months we've responded to record numbers of emails and answered thousands of calls from people in Wiltshire needing advice.

We know this has worked very well for many people, so as we move out of lockdown, we won't be going back to how things were pre-Covid.

From September 2021 we'll continue to help people over the phone, by email and web chat, where that works for them, while reserving our face to face support for when it's most needed. However, we won't be running a drop-in service, so we will be asking people to ring us, or email us first.

This way we can assess the best way of helping people, including booking an appointment where needed. It will also give people the opportunity to get the advice they need, or be signposted to the most appropriate service without having to travel. It also allows us to tailor our face-to-face appointment to the person who has called.

We've already made our Adviceline free to call and we're recruiting more advisors to help answer phone calls and emails. We're also working with partner organisations and community venues to have more access points to our service, particularly for people who are digitally excluded.

We know there will be challenges along the way and we may not always get things right, especially early on, but we'll keep it under review to help ensure we can make our service better for the people that need us today, and in the future.

## **Spin Hill encampment**

A report on Planning Department action sent to Market Lavington Parish Council by Councillor Muns, and included in the Correspondence made available at the October Council Meeting

"I have received a copy of the enforcement notice that has been served on the owner of the land and the person currently using the land on Spin Hill where the portacabins have been installed. The notice forces them to remove everything and return it to as it was.

The notice comes into force on 1st October and until that point the individuals have the right to appeal. Since it contravenes so many Planning points I have been reassured that an appeal will be fruitless.

Once we reach 1st October (assuming there is no appeal) the site must be cleared within 9 months. This is FAR longer than I expected but there are a number of children on site, some with health issues, and therefore this follows national guidance to ensure suitable opportunity for them to rehome themselves."

#### A Message from Cllr Dominic Muns

#### Wiltshire Councillor for The Lavingtons

It can feel frustrating at times that "the system" (however you interpret that!) feels broken. You're not alone, however, I take some comfort in the fact that, when we work together, we can fix things.

Two examples spring to mind; the first being the development of 50 houses in West Lavington which gained planning approval recently. Large scale developments are normally contentious but projects which are planned alongside communities tend to work better. Back in 2011 the Localism Act gave communities the ability to create a "Neighbourhood Plan" allowing residents to set out policies which define how development will happen within their community. West Lavington & Littleton Panell formed a steering group made up of local residents and Parish Councillors and together began producing their Neighbourhood Plan. In it they highlighted important natural, historical and design aspects of the area and identified suitable spaces for future development. The project had the input of hundreds of residents along the way and was approved by referendum which forced Wiltshire Council planners to adopt it.

The field off Lavington Lane was one site highlighted as a suitable location for future development as part of the Neighbourhood Plan. Over the course of the following years Gaigers developed a plan to build 50 houses on the site. Through various public consultations and exhibitions the plans were refined with input from the community and eventually submitted to Planning. Not all residents were supportive of the plan although just three comments were submitted during the consultation which questioned a specific part of the application. I don't attempt to claim that we are all happy about 50 new houses being built, however, as far as a democratic process goes, the community can count this one as a huge win. This development fits our Neighbourhood Plan and, unlike many developments across Wiltshire, this is what residents voted for.

The second example of communities working together is Black Dog crossroads. Back in my July letter I updated you on Wiltshire Council's Highways Department which had collated years of feedback from residents into several potential solutions which they sent out to Parish Councils for wider consideration and comment. I personally attended meetings alongside other interested residents in West Lavington, Market Lavington, Little Cheverell, Great Cheverell and Easterton to hear the discussions around the various ideas. Improved visibility, clearer road markings and reduced speed were the themes consistently raised by residents.

Each Parish Council independently fed their comments back to Highways to help shape a single proposed solution. I am pleased to say that the single proposed solution that Highways produced answers the key points residents raised when they came together at their local parish meetings. From the responses I was included in, Parish Councils have widely supported the proposal and Highways officers have now sent the briefing note to Cllr Mark McClelland, Cabinet Member for Transport. This is significant progress driven by local residents who worked with each other and their local Parish Councils to ensure their voices were heard; well done if you were one of the many involved!
