



Reflection for September 22

As some of you may know, my granddaughter has been seriously ill this summer. It started with nerves over her GCSE's and continued, getting worse for the following three weeks before she was hospitalised. She missed her prom and a family wedding. Life for her immediate family centred around her needs and became all-consuming as her weight dropped from 8st 7 to 6st 2. (She is 5ft. 8in). I prayed, and so did several people here in our villages. Fellow priests prayed and we finally had a diagnoses of Colitis. We breathed a sigh of relief. But three weeks on, very little had changed and she had lost another 2lbs And still doubled up in pain. And then.....

Two days ago I received this email.

"Hi Nana, I wanted you to know I was in a lot of pain last night and couldn't sleep. So I prayed to God to help ease my pain. And he did! I only woke up once in the night and I have had an almost painless day. I have never prayed before and I didn't believe in God but there is something there."

I thank my God for hearing my granddaughters pray. Whatever you perceive God to be, He is out there. Seek and you will find, knock and the door will be opened.

A Message from Cllr Dominic Muns Wiltshire Councillor for The Lavingtons

Whilst thankfully, fuel prices at the petrol pumps have reduced slightly over the last few weeks, I expect, like me, you have concerns about the cost of living, especially as winter approaches. I am pleased that Wiltshire Council has been getting on with distributing the £150 Government energy rebate on council tax bills for households in bands A-D. 140,000 eligible households in Wiltshire have now received their rebate and the council is now working on a further discretionary fund for people on low incomes who live in properties banded E-H. Anyone who has any queries about these rebates should call the revenues team at Wiltshire Council on 0300 456 0109.

Over the next few months many of us should benefit from further assistance with all households receiving £400 off energy bills starting in October. The £400 (non-repayable) discounts from energy suppliers will be paid to consumers over 6 months with payments starting from October 2022. However, more needs to be done. I am not anti-capitalism by any stretch of the imagination but when you have an energy crisis with millions struggling financially it makes me angry to see billion dollar quarterly profits for oil companies or multi-million pound bonuses for energy company bosses. Clearly the balance between adequate taxation and encouraging business to the UK is off.

The background to the global increase in energy costs is complex, and there is a huge task ahead for our next PM, whoever they will be. In the meantime, I would like to promote the Warm and Safe Wiltshire strategy, a commitment from Wiltshire Council and Dorset and Wiltshire Fire & Rescue Service. The energy advice line can provide support with the installation of draught-proofing measures, smoke alarms to improve fire safety and advice on reducing energy use, switching energy suppliers, reducing condensation and damp problems, and controlling heating. There are also Government schemes to further reduce the cost of work, or to pay for it completely if you are unable to afford the cost yourself. More information is available at www.warmandsafewiltshire.org.uk or call the energy advice line on 0800 038 5722.

Finally, I must express my congratulations to all students who have been working hard for their A-Levels and other qualifications. It has been an incredibly testing time for those in education with this year's cohort experiencing unprecedented upheaval thanks to Covid. Whatever your grades, you deserve a huge amount of respect for keeping your heads in the books and showing such resilience. I wish you all the very best for the future in whatever direction you choose to travel. If you have children who have just received their results please pass on my best wishes.

James Carville was a strategist in Bill Clinton's 1992 presidential election campaign against sitting President George H. W. Bush. If campaign workers asked Carville what should be the focus of their messaging, he would reply, "It's the economy, stupid." Contemporary UK politicians would probably do well to take his advice. Whether the top job goes to Rishi Sunak or Liz Truss, their main challenge will be to steer the country through the cost of living crisis.

With utility bills skyrocketing and inflation on the up the new PM is certainly going to have a job on their hands. We all need to make ends meet. As the Charles Dickens character Mr. Micawber reminds us, "Annual income twenty pounds, annual expenditure nineteen six, result happiness. Annual income twenty pounds, annual expenditure twenty pounds nought and six, result misery." Ever the optimist, Mr Micawber hoped that something would turn up to solve his financial woes. I trust that Prime Minister Sunak or Truss will have a better strategy than that.

The Bible wasn't written to give politicians detailed guidance on how to run the economy, but it has a word or two to say about money matters. The Good Book insists that the poor should be provided for and warns that those who exploit the needy will be held to account. "Let justice roll on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream!" thundered the prophet Amos. The wealthy are told not "to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God".

Jesus teaches us to value true riches, "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." Jesus is the giver of treasure in heaven, "you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich."


Proms season from Devizes Town Band

Proposed changes in the law will help reduce plastic in our oceans

An estimated 11 billion wet wipes are disposed of in this country each year and during the pandemic the number being used increased significantly. Many of these wipes are described as "flushable" because they are biodegradable, but it can take up to 100 years for a wet wipe to degrade. When wet wipes are flushed away, they can end up congealed with fat in the sewers or end up on our beaches.

In November 2021, the river charity, Thames21, released data showing that a mound of wet wipes, the size of two tennis courts and over a metre tall, had grown at the side of the river over the last 6 years.

The marine Conservation Trust reported that wet wipes are one of the most common litter items found on UK beaches; last year in their Great British Beach Clean they discovered 18 wet wipes for every 100 metres of beach.

90% of wet wipes contain plastic such as polyester, polyethylene and polypropylene. These plastics break down into microplastics which are small enough to be ingested by marine life, affecting their development and entering the food chain.

For many people, particularly parents of young children, wet wipes are an important part of the toolkit. However, wet wipes don't need to contain plastic to be effective and Fleur Anderson, MP and mother of 4, has introduced a Private Members Bill to prohibit the manufacture and sale of wet wipes containing plastic. This Bill, which has support from across the House, is due to have its second reading on 16th September.

Some manufacturers have already made changes to their own brand products to make them plastic free and some stores are offering sustainable alternatives **What can you do to help?**

- If you don't need to, don't use wipes!
- If you need to use wipes, make sure they are plastic free and don't flush them unless they meet the "Fine to Flush" specification.
- Contact your MP and ask for their support with the second reading of the Plastic Bill on 16th September:
