Have your say on where new homes should go

Deadline nears for comments on proposed housing sites

VILLAGERS are being urged to give their views on where new housing could be built before the consultation deadline on December 20.

Seventeen possible housing sites were reviewed for their suitability, availability and achievability by independent infrastructure consultants AECOM and their full report can be found on the Neighbourhood Plan website at www.marketlavingtonnp2.org.uk/aecom-site-options-and-assessment-report/.

The website has a link to a Feedback Survey where villagers can comment on as many of the sites as they wish. Paper forms are available at the village library and the Community Hall.

The Wiltshire Local Plan backed by Government policy determines that Market Lavington must accommodate some new housing. One of the few ways the parish can influence where the new homes are built is by allocating sites for housing in the new Market Lavington Neighbourhood Plan, which is currently being updated because the existing plan expires next year.

Another advantage of having an up-to-date Neighbourhood Plan is that the parish council gets a greater share of the Community Infrastructure Levy payments paid to Wiltshire Council whenever new homes are built. These can be used to fund local projects and infrastructure, e.g. CIL payments helped pay for the installation of new children's play equipment at Broadwell.

The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group is asking villagers to say which of the proposed housing sites are most suitable and why — as well as which sites are unsuitable. People are asked to give specific reasons e.g. proximity to village services, ease of access or flood risk. Copies of evidence relating to the suitability of any of the sites, such as photos of flooding or reports about road accidents, can be emailed to the steering group at contact@marketlavingtonNP2.org.uk.

The Steering Group will produce a draft Neighbourhood Plan, which will undergo a six-week public consultation, before submission to Wiltshire Council for examination. If approved, there will be a village referendum when it must receive a majority of votes cast before it is adopted.

The musical Hamilton has been a big hit, with acclaimed performances on Broadway and London's West End. The Hamilton in question is Alexander Hamilton (circa 1755-1804). The American politician was involved in the Revolutionary War against the British and became the first US secretary to the treasury under George Washington. Hamilton helped to frame the constitution of the newly established republic. The life of Founding Father seems like an unlikely subject for an all singing, all dancing musical, but it works.

My wife and I recently saw the film version of a Broadway performance of the musical, released to mark the show's tenth anniversary. We went in part to see what all the fuss was about and quite enjoyed it. Act II certainly packs an emotional punch. Without giving away too many spoilers, Hamilton becomes estranged from his wife, Eliza. A terrible tragedy then strikes their family, following which they are reconciled. The drama of the moment is carried forward by the song It's Quiet Uptown.

In the song, a grieving Hamilton acknowledges that he is undeserving of his wife's love. Surveying the scene, Eliza's sister Angelica reflects, 'there is a grace too powerful to name'. As the couple hold hands as a gesture of reconciliation the chorus sings, 'forgiveness, can you imagine?' Watching this unfold, I'm thinking, 'Preach it. Amen to that!'

Better still, what happened at the first Christmas revealed that grace indeed has a name. In the New Testament Paul writes of God's grace 'which has now been manifested through the appearing of our Saviour, Christ Jesus.' Grace is God's love for underserving sinners, lavished upon us in Jesus. The Son of God came to die in our place that we may be reconciled to God and have our sins forgiven. Forgiveness, can you imagine? You can do more than imagine by receiving God's gift of forgiveness by faith in Jesus. That's the power of grace.

A Message from Cllr Dominic Muns Wiltshire Councillor for The Lavingtons

I won't apologise for being political this month; you'll see why. Six months after Wiltshire's elections left the Council in "no overall control", the Liberal Democrats scraped together votes from Independent councillors and concerns are growing over their leadership.

Previously, Council finances were so well managed we were able to invest an extra £22m into Highways, improving roads locally, including Black Dog. Last year Wiltshire Council ranked best-performing council in the southwest and 7th out of 151 nationally.

How quickly things have changed. Since May the new administration has authorised spend of almost £7m; money they did not need to spend and can't afford. Expect cuts to services and a maximum council tax increase to pay for it.

Where has this £7m gone? A huge chunk (I am not allowed to tell you how much) is being given to a private individual (I am not allowed to tell you who) along with a publicly owned multistorey carpark on a 1.7-acre site in central Trowbridge. Yes, you read that right - the Liberal Democrat Cabinet has agreed to give £Xmillion of taxpayer money to a person who will likely redevelop the site into flats, making tens of millions of pounds for themself. The details of the transaction were recently leaked and can be found online and in the local paper but I am still banned from talking about it!

I have publicly questioned this "deal" (which has been done behind closed doors) several times. You may have seen in the news that I brought a temporary halt to proceedings by forcing it through an extraordinary scrutiny committee. Frustratingly *some* councillors on the committee (I'm not allowed to tell you who, but you can probably guess) voted it through. I refused to give up the fight, and this is where the story has now taken a very dark turn.

A few weeks ago, I personally received a threat of legal action from a trade union representing a council employee AND a separate Wiltshire Council Standards complaint for speaking out against this deal. Lawyers acting for me mounted a robust defence, but this aggression has caught the eye of the Free Speech Union. Furthermore, this holier-than-thou administration is constantly talking about "openness and transparency" whilst actively shutting down criticism and scrutiny. 

BLACK DOG CROSSROADS ROADWORKS INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC LIGHTS UPDATE

Road closures will also be in place on the A360, C20 Cheverell Road, Worton, and C20 Broadway, Market Lavington (October 23rd - February 2026)

During this time, temporary traffic signals and a speed limit restriction will be in place on the A360 to allow work to be carried out safely.

Managed access will be maintained on Broadway for over height vehicles, using traffic signals and the onsite team.

Cheverell Road is due to reopen on December 8, but all other traffic measures are expected to remain in place until at least February 13th.

Towards the end of the programme, overnight road closures will be required on all arms of the junction for carriageway resurfacing, traffic signal detector loop cutting and road marking works.

The exact dates and times of these road closures have not yet been set and Wiltshire Council will release more details closer to the time.
