## **New plan seeks to protect and enhance natural environment and biodiversity**

Protecting and enhancing Market Lavington's natural environment and biodiversity are key priorities in the draft Vision and Objectives in the proposed new Neighbourhood Plan.

The Vision is an aspirational view into the future, which sees the parish protecting its rural character, while strengthening its friendly and thriving village community.

'Nature is woven through daily life as the parish contributes meaningfully to nature recovery,' says the Vision. It supports the provision of additional green space to benefit the whole community.

The vision is reflected in the Objectives, which cover everything from measures to protect the parish against the effects of climate change to ensuring any new housing reflects the needs of the community.

Market Lavington has no choice but to accept some new housing as this is decided by Wiltshire Council in its Local Plan. The existing Market Lavington Neighbourhood Plan expires in May and producing a new one will help the community to influence the types of homes built and where they are located.

“Lord, it is good for us to be here; if you wish, I will make three dwellings here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah” (Matthew 17: 4)

John Hacket, seventeenth-century Bishop of Lichfield, preached that offering to build dwellings for Jesus, Moses, and Elijah was “...the greatest error that St Peter committed”. Hacket’s verdict has always struck me as somewhat harsh. True, Peter does not respond to a scene of unearthly glory with a paean of awestruck wonder. But then Peter was a fisherman. He was good with his hands. He was used to mending boats, gutting fish, and patching up nets. Brought face to face with the light of Heaven he reverts to type. What can he do? Make some ‘dwellings’ – obviously!

It’s a relief to me that we read a Gospel account of the Transfiguration on the Sunday next before Lent, that we catch a glimpse of the divine before we descend to the wilderness and begin the weeks of penitence and fasting. It’s a relief to me because St Peter manifestly fails to rise to the occasion. He does not do what the circumstances seem to demand. He does not utter beautiful words that we still sing as a canticle in our worship. He does not leave the mountain-top with a serene countenance and a steadfast heart, forever a changed man. No. He reverts to type. He offers to get his chisel and plane out and knock something together.

And this is a relief because the weeks of Lent compel me to acknowledge that, like St Peter, I very rarely rise to the occasion. I make vows about abstinence and study, only to break them. I receive ash on my forehead and daub it on the foreheads of others, only to find myself thinking about my supper. I hear the gorgeous music of the Cathedral choir and walk in solemn procession behind them, only to obsess about impossible neighbours, unwritten sermons, and difficult colleagues. In short, I revert to type – gluttonous, distracted, and cross.

But perhaps the expectation that I might rise to God’s occasion or live up to God’s moment is just one more example of human vanity, one more instance in which I’m convinced it’s all about me. It’s not. Lent, however imperfectly observed, leads to Passiontide, when God in Jesus does not rise to the occasion. He descends to it. To the scourge, to the nails, to the crown of thorns. He comes down the mountain and joins us. And that’s why there is hope.

In July 2024 on BBC Question Time political commentator Andrew Marr hailed the election of the new Labour government led by Sir Keir Starmer with these words, "For the first time in many of our lives, actually Britain looks like a little haven of peace and stability". With near constant speculation in the media over how much longer Starmer will occupy 10 Downing Street, Marr's quote hasn't aged well.

On being elected the Prime Minister pledged to clean up public life. Then In February 2025 he proceeded to appoint Peter Mandelson as UK Ambassador to the United States of America. Starmer was forced to sack him from that role some seven months later, once Mandelson's links to convicted sex offender Jeffrey Epstein were revealed. The scandal blew up again last month when the publication of the Epstein files laid bare the full extent of the former ambassador's relationship with the disgraced financier. As I write despite the backlash Starmer has managed to cling on as Prime Minister.

My point isn't a party political one. Politicians of all stripes have been involved scandals over the years. So have high up business people, figures from the church and members of the royal family. As the Soviet dissident Alexander Solzhenitsyn reflected, "The line separating good and evil passes not through states, nor between classes, nor between political parties either—but right through every human heart".

Recent events are a stark reminder of our fallen humanity. No matter how high we may rise, there is something within us that brings us back to earth with a bump. The Bible calls that something 'sin'. Our political leaders have no answer to this problem, for they like us are part of the problem. But God has an answer, and his answer is Jesus. The Son of God came into the world to save us by dying on the cross for our sins. By faith in him we may be forgiven and be put right with God. That's good news for each and every one of us.

## **A Message from Cllr Dominic Muns    Wiltshire Councillor for The Lavingtons**

I am currently preparing for the Council's annual budget meeting on the 24th February. This year, due to the "No Overall Control" situation, we will discuss not just a Liberal Democrat budget but also an alternative Conservative one. With a revenue budget of over £500m, it is essential we agree on an approach that works for Wiltshire residents. You will have read about numerous U-turns in the press over the last month; HRC closures and cuts to Link community transport being two which the Cabinet hastily retracted after huge public outrage. The administration also proposes to completely ignore Full Council's January ruling NOT to give a Yorkshire businessman £2.5m and a multistorey car park, by adding it back into their budget! Even more worrying is the plan to use our reserves (emergency savings) to cover overspend across the council rather than addressing the reasons for the overspend. This would leave us in a position where spend continues to spiral out of control whilst our financial safety net rapidly disappears.

The roads across the country are in a shocking state due to decades of underinvestment by central government (predominantly Conservative but Labour too). In 2024/25 Wiltshire Council added tens of millions of pounds to its highways budget to boost works. I am sure you will agree with me that in the last year the roads have noticeably and significantly deteriorated. Getting to Devizes on the A360 now risks serious vehicle damage. The reason is simple; the administration which took over in May 2025 has failed to invest ANY additional money in road maintenance. Realising their mistake, in their new budget they want to invest £15m into roads to catch-up, however, unlike in previous years, they are planning to borrow the money. Over the course of the loan, they claim the £15m they want to spend will cost you and me (and our children) £58m to repay!

I cannot, in good conscience, support a proposal which ignores overspending and burdens future generations with compounding debt to fix roads. I will not be supporting the proposed budget when it comes to Full Council this month. Instead, I will be supporting the alternative budget which promises to get a grip on the overspending, introduces new innovative revenue streams such as renting road space to utilities companies who need to dig them up, therefore generating income from the disruption whilst incentivizing them to finish works swiftly. The current way, where they simply pay an admin fee to close the road does not encourage them to work quickly and does not value the disruption you and I have to put up with.

By the time you read this in print I hope Wiltshire will have a sustainable and responsible budget. Even if we don't, we should have the works at Black Dog finished and working! Repairs to the A360 between us and Potterne should also have been made AND we will be just over a fortnight from a resurfaced B3098 between West Lavington crossroads and Lavington School.        As always, I will keep you updated.
