Market Lavington Surgery

Closure of Urchfont Branch Surgery

Reluctantly Market Lavington Surgery has taken the difficult decision to close our branch surgery at Urchfont Village Hall on the 31st of December 2023. We appreciate that this might not come as a surprise to you as we have been unable to provide services there since the pandemic.

As you may know, the opening of the Devizes Health Centre was an opportunity for us, as an average sized practice, to reconsider how we provide care. This was with a view to us becoming more resilient and responsive to patient demand for appointments. To do this, we contribute some of our workforce to the collaborative team of clinicians who work at the Devizes Health Centre. Whilst we now have more clinical staff to provide this service and our routine appointments at the main surgery, we are unable to reintroduce clinics at Urchfont Surgery. We have not considered this option lightly and we hope that you understand our reasoning for the decision we have had to take.

We would like to reassure all our patients that our service will run as normal at Market Lavington, the practice is 2 miles from Urchfont surgery and is purpose built to meet the healthcare requirements of its patients. When the pandemic forced the closure of the Urchfont practice our patient base adapted well to the change and visited our main surgery without too much inconvenience caused. Any housebound patients registered with the surgery in the village continued to receive the same support and continuation of care in the community as before.

Therefore, the proposal to make the closure permanent is not without precedence as we have already had a significant impact trial period for the last three years.

We would like to thank the community of Urchfont for their support during our residency in Urchfont. We are saddened to leave our rural outpost but have had to put the needs of our patient base as a whole first and foremost, in our planned activity.

Christianity in decline?

According to a survey cited in the Times newspaper, around 75% of Church of England clergy believe that the UK can no longer be called a Christian country. The latest census data bears that out. In 2011 the number of people identified as Christian was 60%, but by 2021 that had dropped to 46%.

For hardline secularists the decline of Christianity in our country may be an occasion for rejoicing. But as Rod Liddle argued in a recent column in The Sunday Times, what we're left with as Christian influence has receded is a more individualistic society, devoted to the pursuit of material gain. The trouble is that looking after number 1 and buying endless stuff online hardly satisfies the deepest longings of our souls.

Similarly, as Celia Walden reflected in an article in the Daily Telegraph, we've swapped the worship of God for the worship of self, "as a secular society, we've thrown ourselves into the cult of self, precisely because we're flailing, with no basic spiritual scaffold to keep us steady." Welcome to the brave new post-Christian world.

But if we broaden our perspective to take in the global picture, Christianity is not in decline. The faith is advancing in China, Africa, South America and even Iran. Here in the UK Rod Liddle points to the "rapidly growing numbers attending Pentecostal and evangelical churches — where eternal biblical certainties are still enjoined upon the worshippers".

The worship of self and wealth are poor God-substitutes. The eternal biblical certainties set before us the one true and living God who is worth worshipping. He is the God who sent his Son, the Lord Jesus to die for our sins and be raised from the dead that we may have the hope of everlasting life. Jesus calls us to renounce the cult of self saying, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me."

If you are wanting to find a local choir to join you'll like singing with us in the Trowbridge Rock Choir.





Nurture Nature January 2024

Make what you will of COP28, the Conference of the Parties – however after COP27 it was transformational in mentioning finally the intention to cut emissions, so it transpired that it was better than expected. In a last minute change to the final statement it declared a transitional move away from oil, coal and gas. However we shall follow carefully it the biggest fossil fuel producers, China, Russia, India, the US, Saudi Arabia and the Gulf States to start to move away from such, as fossil fuels are the biggest environmental atmospheric polluters.

The BTO (British Trust for Ornithology) has reported that there have been changes to migrant bird patterns – due to habitat loss and climate irregularities. So far this

winter there appear to be fewer winter migrants such as fieldfares, redwings, bramblings in the area. Of course, there will be regional variations around the country. Conversely, there appears to be more migrational movement of blackbirds. Waxwings could appear should the weather harden in Scandinavia. They love rosehips, such as those on rosa Fellenberg. We haven't been alerted to local starling murmurations on the Plain so far this winter. Roosting areas do change, of course, however, this might be a sign of decreasing decline of this hardy species. Some folk have reported bumble bee activity even on cold days. There are such hardy bee species with yellow rears that visit nectar bearing flowering shrubs such as winter flowering honeysuckle, abelia and mahonia. Often bumble bees will fly into sheds, summerhouses etc when doors are open, and thereby they get trapped and die when such outbuildings are shut up, so please check for bumblebees first. Seabirds especially are still suffering from avian 'flu, and our birds of gardens, fields and woods can be affected. So please keep feeders clean, water in bird baths changed daily, and if you haven't cleaned out and checked bird boxes for damage and repair, please try to do so by the end of the month.

If you know of hedgehogs hibernating in your garden please ensure they are safe from domestic pets. We had a terrier particularly interested in our hedgehog boxes so we had to fence them off with chicken wire, cutting a $15 \text{mm} \times 15 \text{mm}$ (6" \times 6") ground level opening for the sow and hoglets to use when born.

Finally, a few words about the spectacular monogamous albatrosses, which lay a single egg every one or two years. The Bycatch kill off these magnificent birds – an estimated 100,000 a year from just high seas fishing fleets. So human activities are threatening to extinction some of the sub species of these majestic birds. No wonder David Attenborough is so concerned about how many species worldwide are declining, and have been ever more rapidly since the 1970s. It is up to us to stem these staggering declines in birds and mammals for the sake of our children and grandchildren.



Parish Steward Scheme

Wiltshire Council provides someone to do highways work around Market Lavington and Easterton, roughly two days each month for Market Lavington and one for Easterton. If you see any of the tasks listed below that need doing in your parish, please contact your respective Parish Clerk, or report it on the MyWiltshire App.

- hand clearing and cutting of growth from drainage grips and drain gully covers.
- hand clearing of blocked gullies.
- rodding of drainage systems
- clearing of small culverts, pipes, and pits
- clearing storm debris
- trimming encroaching hedges and vegetation from around road signs and railings
- cleaning and straightening small road signs.
- hand cutting small visibility areas.
- reactive emergency repairs including pothole repairs (In accordance with Wiltshire Councils Highways Inspection Manual 2018)
- find, fix & record potholes (cold repairs only)
- removal of ragwort (hand pulling or strimming of defined areas)
- treatment/removal of weeds
- graffiti and fly posting removal.
- clearance of debris and materials from scenes of road traffic collisions including clinical waste.
- siding out of footways and carriageways
- clearance of storm damaged trees from the Highway including the use of a chainsaw

Music played by Andrew Hurst created just the right atmosphere - a very special and happy event.

Finally from 28th Nov. to 5th December '23 it was the BigGive online matchfunding Christmas Challenge where donations made to the Nestling Trust were doubled. Thank you so much to everyone who donated we are most grateful.

The amount raised through the three events is approximately an incredible £16,500. Proceeds will be used to help staff the Baiteshwor Health & Birthing Centre and make an emergency vehicle access road, it will also help support the Sarangkot Nestling Children's Home as well as helping survivors of the Earthquake in Western Nepal. 



Crime prevention advice to help reduce burglaries in Wiltshire

Det Insp Darren Ambrose, of the Wiltshire Police Burglary Team, said: "Burglary is one of the most impactive crimes that a member of the public can suffer. Your home is the place you should feel most safe and secure and somebody breaking in can change the life of a victim and their family forever. That is why burglary is a priority for the Force and why we are taking steps to improve our approach to dealing with residential burglary.

Lock your doors and windows every time you leave the house, even when just in the garden. And make sure you have approved locks or bolts to all doors and windows.

Never leave a spare key in a hiding place like in a plant pot or letter box - a thief knows all the hiding places.

Keep all keys, purses and wallets out of sight and away from the letterbox. Register all serial numbers from electrical items, tools and garden equipment with Immobilise.com the free national property register. Mark items without serial numbers with an artificial DNA property marker such as Smartwater or SelectaDNA.

Take photographs of all jewellery including hallmarks and keep them safe. Make sure that you have up to date contents insurance.

Use a timer to set lights to mimic your usual activity when you are not at home.

Do not open the door to anyone you don't know or are not expecting. Always check by using a spy-hole or look through a window. Don't trust an ID card. Trim back any plants and hedges at the front of your property to no higher than one meter to remove hiding places.

Always report any suspicious activity, note any vehicle registrations, descriptions of persons involved and direction of travel.

Consider installing a monitored burglar alarm, and only use a company that is registered or certified with the NSI or the SSIAB.

Burglary is an operational priority here in Wiltshire as outlined by Chief Constable Catherine Roper at the start of the year. Since April, there have been 327 residential burglaries – a 15 per cent decrease on the same time period last year.


